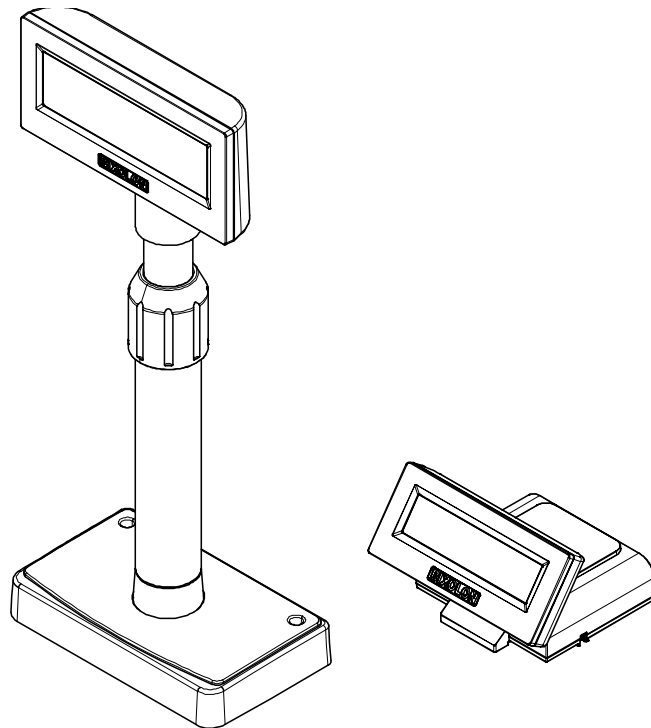

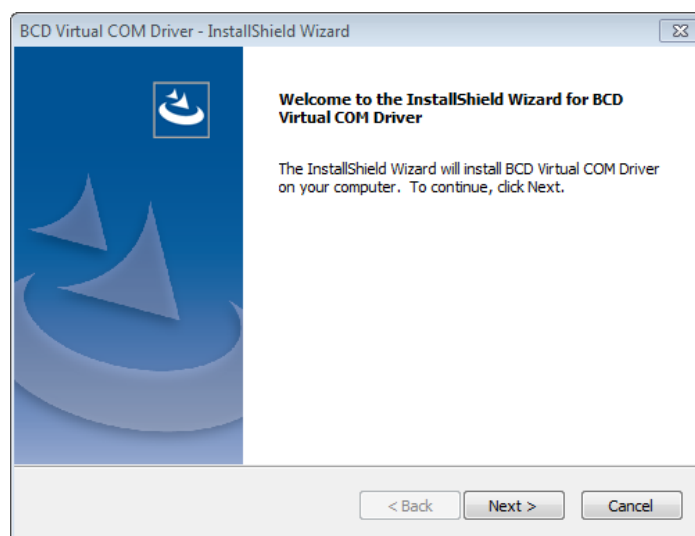
3. Virtual COM for USB Driver Installation & Uninstallation

- Installation and uninstallation process in this document is written based on Windows 7.

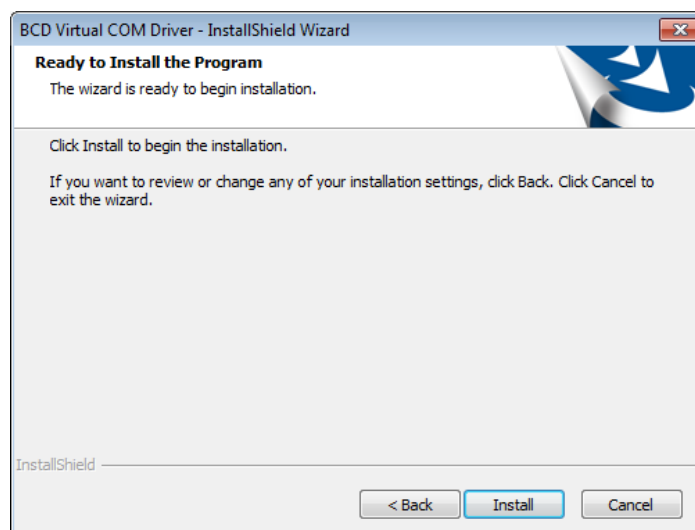
3-1 Installation

Caution or warning - Install with all the cables disconnected from the display device.

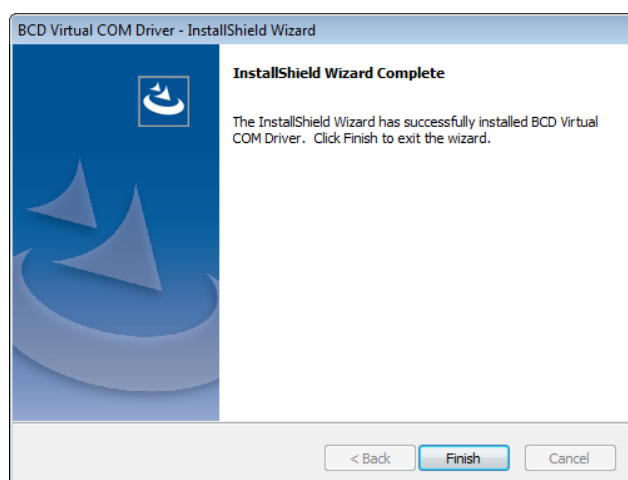
- 1) Execute the installation file. (BCD_VCOM4USB_Vx.x.x.exe)
- 2) Click the “Next” button.



- 3) Click “Install” to begin the installation.

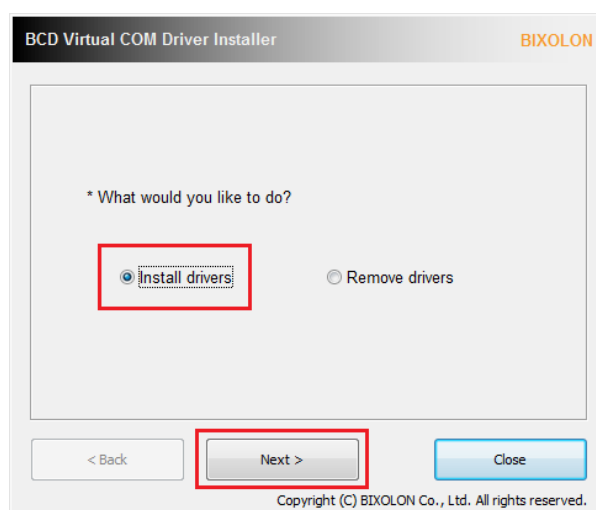


4) Click “Finish”.

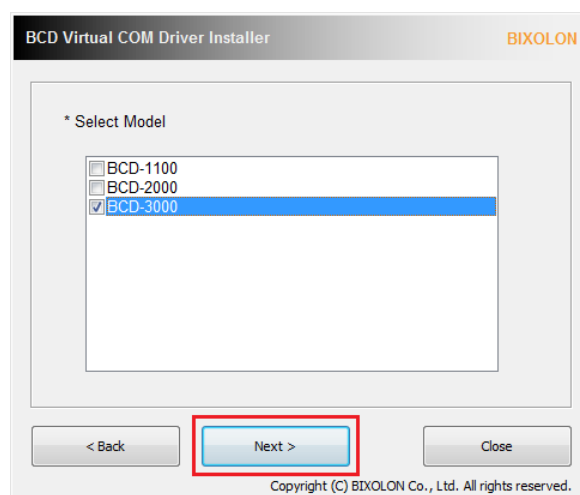


5) Select from “Start ► All Programs ► BIXOLON” and open “BCD VCOM Driver Installer”.

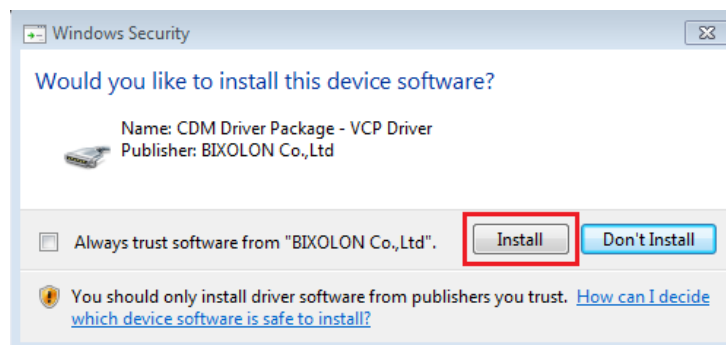
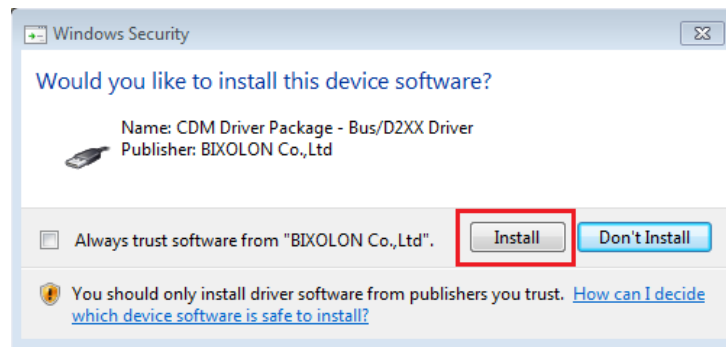
6) Choose “Install drivers” option and click “Next”.



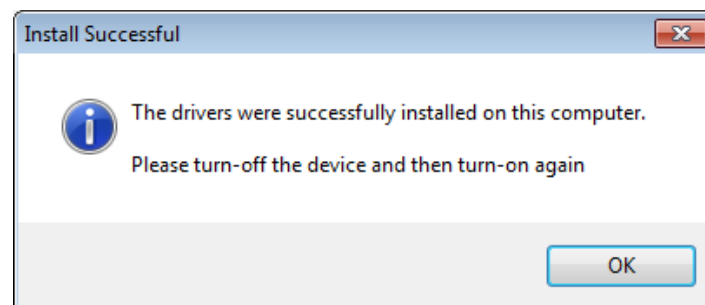
7) Check the model for installation and click “Next”.



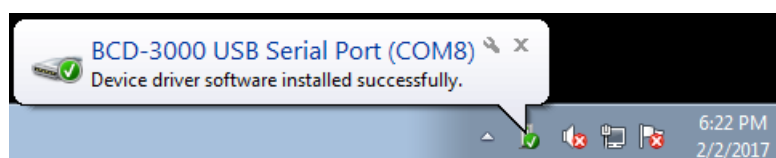
8) When the following message box appears, click the "Install" button.



9) The following message appears upon the successful completion of installation.

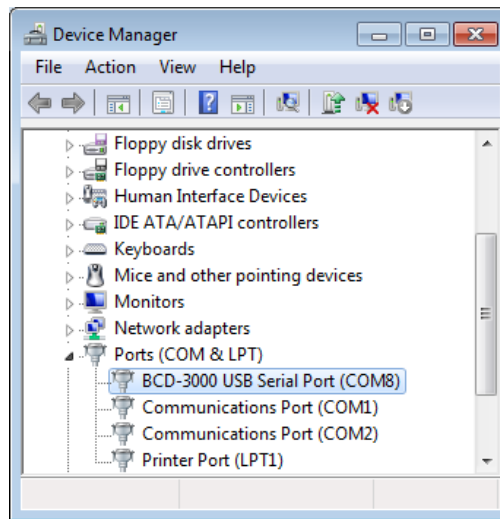


10) The installation starts when connecting the display device to the PC.
The following message will appear at the bottom-right corner of the screen as shown in the image when the installation is complete.

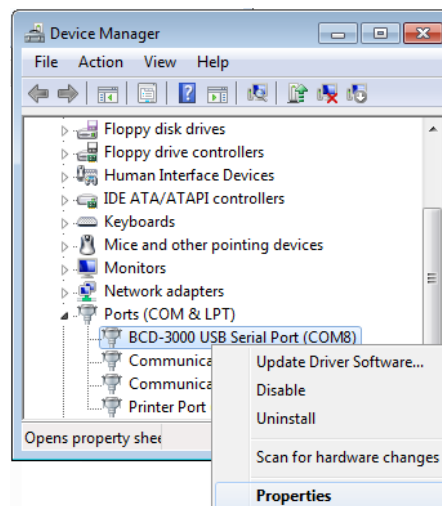


11) Go to Control Panel ► System ► Device Manager: Upon examination of the ports (COM & LPT) section and check the BCD-xxx USB Serial Port (COMx).

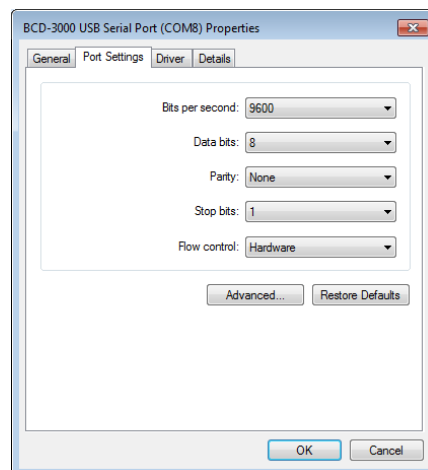
* The COM port is automatically numbered, and it varies according to PC port occupation conditions.



12) Select BCD-xxx USB Serial Port(COMx) and right-click. Then select Properties.



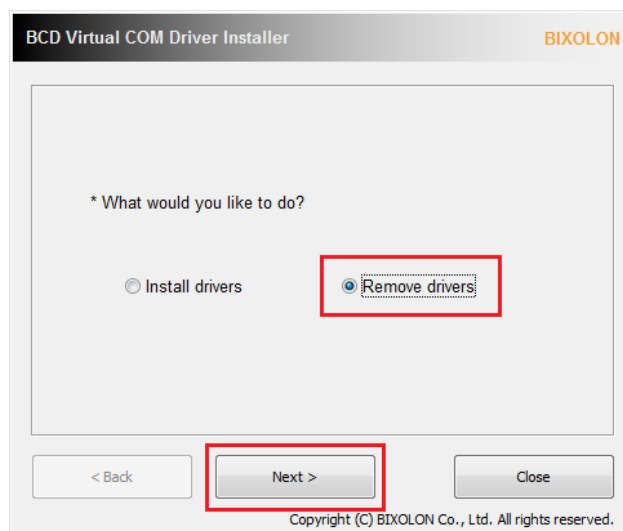
13) Check the serial communication settings.



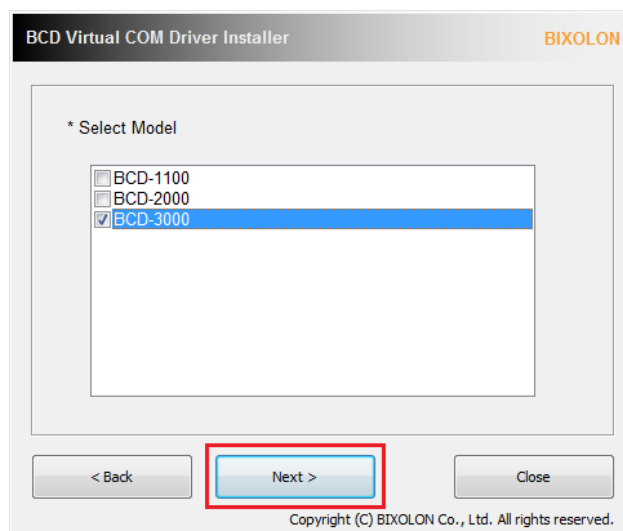
Caution or warning - The flow control option should be set to "Hardware".

3-2 Uninstallation

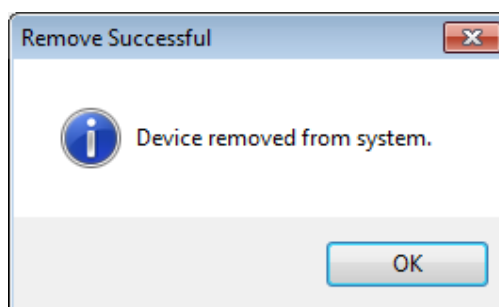
- 1) Select from “Start ► All Programs ► BIXOLON” and open “BCD VCOM Driver Installer”.
